

DEAR PARENTS !

Zoltán Maruzsa, Secretary of State for Public Education Mr. On 20 May 2020, a notification proposal was published "215/2020. (V.20.) On the reopening of kindergartens and crèches and on the organization of a summer camp "2020. expected lifestyle on the normal opening hours of the stock exchange on 02 June '.

It is not possible to restore the emergency situation, so the nurseries will become sustainable in consultation with them, in the future we will give priority to the recommendations contained in the guidelines issued by the National Center for Public Health.

In addition to initiating the public health-epidemiological unnecessary, keeping in mind and eliminating the principles of pre-school education should be more rigorous but flexible than usual.

1. THE BACKGROUND OF THE LAWS



- 215/2020. (V.20.) On the reopening of kindergartens and nurseries and on the organization of a summer camp
- Information on the epidemiological need for nursery and kindergarten education
- Recommendation of the National Faculty of Education regarding the reopening of kindergartens

It applies to all families in terms of reopening, but it is not compulsory !

The cashier of the kindergarten notified you of the payment staff criterion in an email yesterday. If you would like to bring your children to kindergarten, please arrange care as soon as possible and please submitting applications in the usual way!

Parents are asked to observe the following rules for the protection of children and staff in the institution:

2.HEALTH MEASURES



- Only **healthy children** can be admitted to the institution. The parent can bring his or her healthy child to the institution without a statement and medical paper!
- Parents are asked **to wear a mask** upon arrival and stay at the institution!
- The **disinfectant fluid** at the gate is used immediately each time!
- In all cases, the child must be accompanied by **only one relative** who is under 65 years of age.
- Please continue to arrive in the morning in accordance with our Rules of Procedure!
- **Deadline for receipt no later than 8.30**
- **Parents are not allowed to enter the nursery school!** In good weather, the groups gather in the yard, and the farewell to the child and the handing over of the child should be carried out there as soon as possible and in a manner that seeks to keep a sufficient distance. Please pack your child's belongings in a marked backpack, which our Colleagues will help the children arrange. Please provide changing clothes to suit the season and the weather. On arrival in the afternoon, children can be picked up in the courtyard as soon as possible. In case of bad weather, signal their arrival by **ringing at the gate** and the nurses will arrange for the children to be handed over.
- Please apply sunscreen to children's skin at home in high heat!
- **Do not put toys, food or drink in children's bags!**



3.EPIDEMIOLOGY MEASURES

- The institution maintains constant **contact with the kindergarten doctor and nurse** during this period as well.
- We constantly comply with the **relevant epidemiological regulations** (disinfections, protective clothing, personal and material hygiene).
- Only soft items needed for sleep that **can be disinfected by the parent on a daily basis** may be brought into the institution!

- Children's **play clothes should be changed daily** and disinfected using an appropriate washing technique.
- If we notice a **deterioration in the child's state of health**, the child will be **separated immediately**, and it is the parent's responsibility to come for his or her child as soon as possible after notification! The healed child can then be admitted to kindergarten again with a **medical certificate**.



AGENDA AND GROUP RULES

- **When opened on June 2, 2020, each child will be placed in their own group, they will meet their own kindergarten teacher and nurse. As care needs change, groups are constantly merging**
- During this period, the sessions in the group do not continue as usual. Individual development opportunities are integrated into everyday life, especially for children going to school.
- Kindergarten teachers organize several outdoor games, competitions and craft activities for children.
- Groups follow **the rules of summer life**.
- As we spend more time outdoors, the yard is also the place to gather for breakfast.
- In the great heat of summer, we make sure that **children drink as much fluid as possible**. In addition, we ask you to support children's healthy eating with fresh **fruits and vegetables!**
- In high heat, children will take a shower as usual.
- **In order to reduce the risk of infection, afternoon rest should preferably be taken by children for whom supervision cannot be arranged at home. This avoids crowded placement of beds next to each other!**



5. OTHER INFORMATION

- It is not obligatory to use kindergarten care during this period, so we accept a longer certificate. (For example, from 06/06/2020 to 31/08/2020.) **If you do not want to bring your child, please indicate in the form of an e-mail, indicating the exact dates of your absence!**
- Preliminary needs assessment is not equivalent to certification!
- We will inform you about the summer closing of the institution later.
